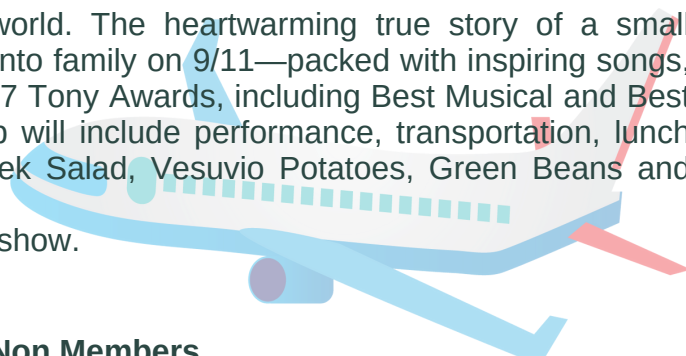

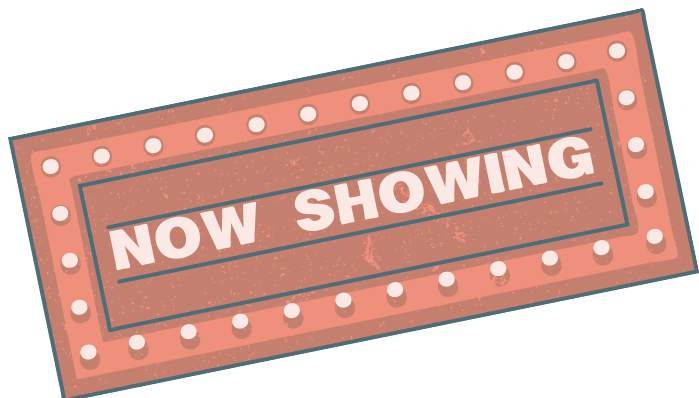
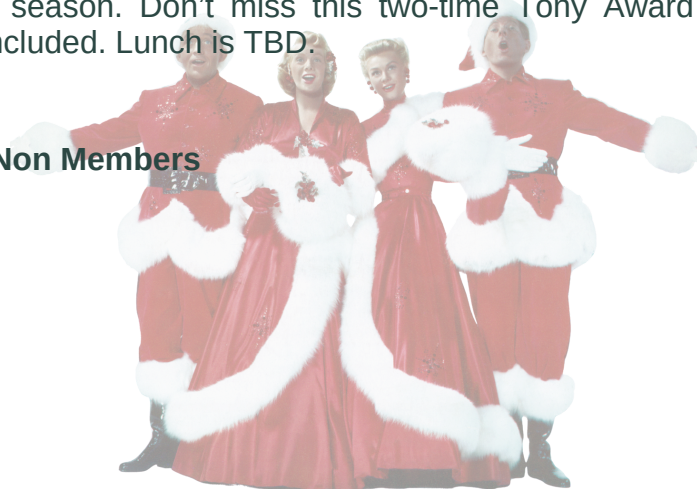


## White Christmas

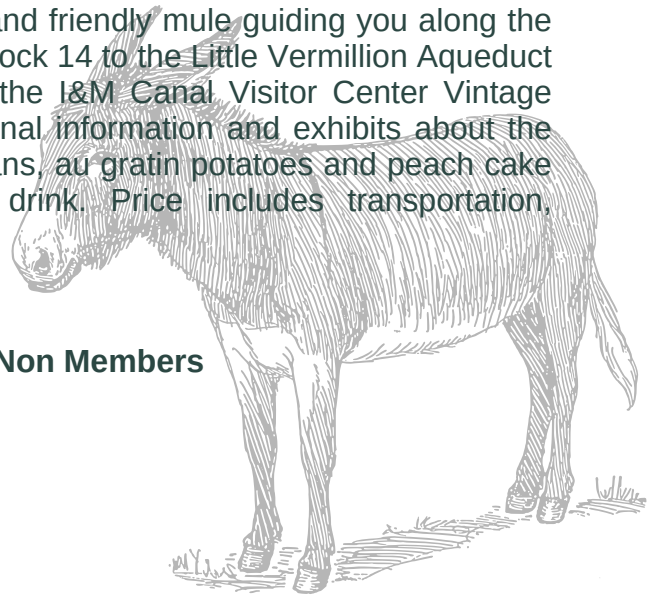




## I&M Canal Tour & Lunch

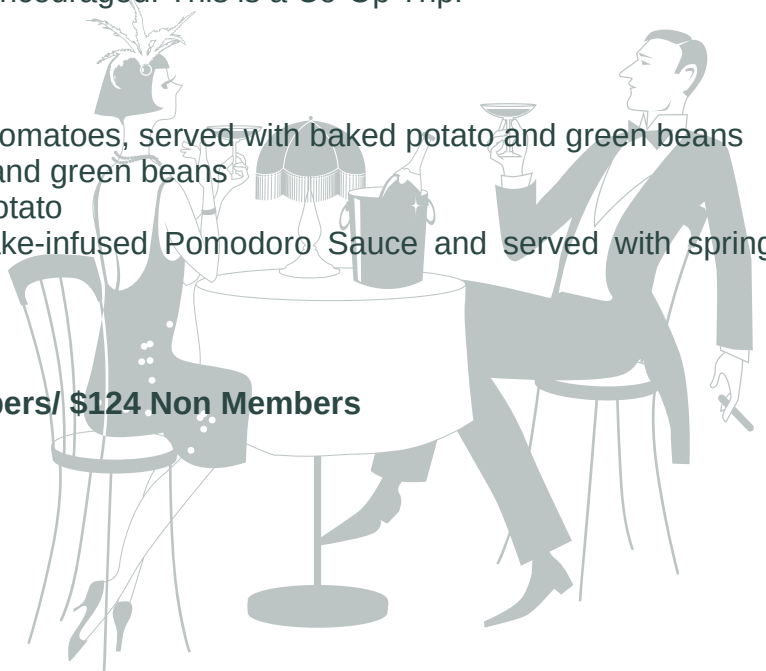

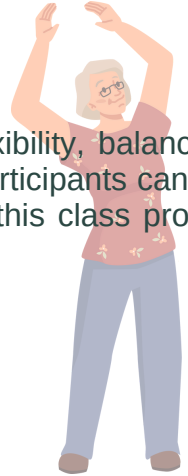

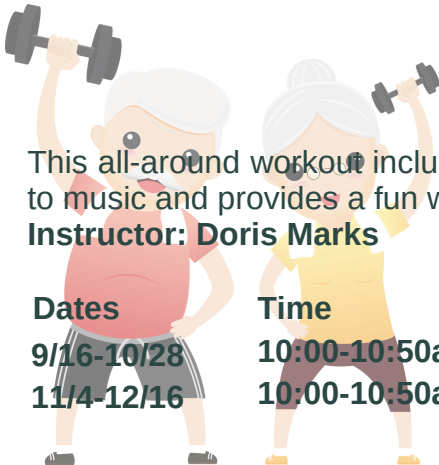

### Apiary Beekeeping

Have you ever wanted to keep honeybees and enjoy the best honey you have ever tasted? To enhance the growing interest in urban beekeeping, the Pleasant Dale Park District is now offering a community apiary. You can keep up to three hives in the apiary to explore the world of beekeeping. First-year beekeepers are required to have completed a beekeeping class prior to the installation of beehives. Registration with the Illinois Department of Agriculture and adherence to their rules and regulations, as well as site-specific rules, must be agreed to prior to the installation of hives. All beekeepers must also have a Certificate of Insurance listing Pleasant Dale Park District as additionally insured on the certificate. Our Pleasant Dale-appointed apiary liaison, Thad Ryniak, will be able to answer specific questions and help guide novice beekeepers through the basics of getting started. 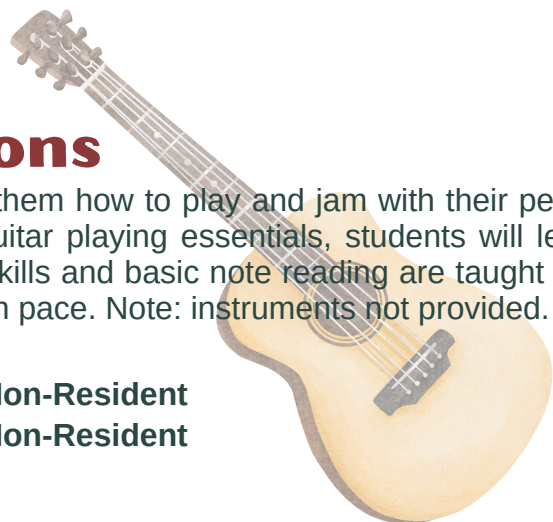




## Beginner Group Guitar Lessons
