

NOTICE OF BID

Pleasant Dale Park District (the "District") is accepting sealed bids for the Improvements to the Soehrman Park Splash Pad. Sealed bids must be submitted on or before 2:00 PM Monday, April 22, 2019 to the Pleasant Dale Park District Office at 7425 S. Wolf Rd. Burr Ridge, Illinois 60527. Immediately thereafter, bids will be opened and read aloud.

Questions will be answered in the form of written addenda and provided to all Bidders, as per State of Illinois statutes. Submit questions regarding the bid in writing to Planning Resources, shalberg@planres.com no later than 2:00 PM on April 16, 2019. An optional pre-bid meeting will occur at the site on April 15, 2019 at 2:00 PM.

This work is largely related to the replacement of existing ground level spray ports and the installation of Owner supplied above ground spray toys. The work includes demolition of existing concrete in preparation for the installation of the new above ground spray toys, splash pad concrete flatwork with reinforcement, installation of a new PVC supply line for one of the spray toys, removal of existing concrete color coating in preparation of a new color surface, application of a new multi-color surface application, miscellaneous work related to the installation of the new above ground spray toys, installation, maintenance, and removal of a stabilized construction entrance, construction security fencing, silt fencing. The new spray toys are Owner supplied contractor/bidder installed.

The bid packet, specifications and plans are available electronically. Interested contractors may obtain detailed proposal specifications and plans via electronic download through the Accurate Repro, Inc. Online Plan room at <http://www.accurateplanroom.com/>. A Plan Fee is required for each electronic download at \$25.00 per set. Plans will be available starting April 9, 2019.

The contractor awarded the contract will be required to post a performance bond, labor and material payment bond in a penal amount equal to the contract price, plus insurance meeting District requirements.

This contract calls for the construction of a "public work", within the meaning of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01, *et seq.* (the "Act") The Act requires contractors and subcontractors to pay laborers and workers performing services on public works projects no less than the "prevailing rate of wages" (hourly cash wages plus fringe benefits) in the county where the work is performed. For information regarding current prevailing wage rates, please refer to the Illinois Department of Labor's website at: <http://www.state.il.us/agency/idol/rates>. All contractors and subcontractors rendering services under this contract must comply with all requirements of the Act, including but not limited to, all wage, notice and record keeping duties. For the entire duration of this work under the Contract, the Contractor shall conform to the federal and state statutes on equal opportunity and fair employment. Submission of required certified payroll records will be required prior to payment by Owner to the installation contractor.

This notice shall not create any legal obligation on behalf of the District to evaluate any bid that is submitted by a contractor, or to enter into any contract with a contractor submitting a bid. The District reserves the right to (1) cancel or modify this notice or the contract documents in whole or in part; (2) reject any or all bids submitted; (3) waive non-material formalities and technicalities deemed

appropriate; (4) postpone bid opening; (5) issue a call for new bids; and/or (6) award the contract for the project in whole or in part, or to one or more contractors.
